 33 YEARS OLD, WHITE MALE, HEIGHT 5'10", MEDIUM BUILD, WEIGHT
 170 - 175 POUNDS. ACCORDING TO THE SOURCE, PERDUE APPEARS TO
 BE A MERCENARY WHO USES SKILLS LEARNED IN THE U. S. ARMED FORCES
 IN VIETNAM. THERE IS NO ADDRESS KNOWN FOR PERDUE OTHER THAN
 THE FACT THAT HE IS FROM THE HOUSTON AREA. SOURCE PROVIDED A
